

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

Contributions to *Paideuma* are welcomed. Manuscripts, in either German, English or French, must be typed double-spaced and submitted in duplicate. An overcorrected manuscript may be returned to the author for re-submission. Authors are advised to incorporate footnote material within the text wherever possible. References cited should consist of the author's surname, the year of publication, and page, e.g. Baumann 1963: 31 or if the author is mentioned in the text, merely by date and page, e.g. 1963: 31. Footnotes are to be numbered throughout the paper and are to be typed on a separate sheet. On a further sheet should be given a complete bibliography of all works cited, arranged alphabetically by authors and chronologically for each author. Maps and other line drawings should be submitted in final form and size (max. A 4) on good quality tracing paper. Figures should be numbered and captioned. It should be indicated where these are to appear. Photographs can only be reproduced after consultation with the editor. Authors are asked to be sparing in the use of diacritics.

Authors receive page proofs of articles, which are to be read carefully and returned as soon as possible. Where proofs are not received in time, the editor will send the printer his own corrected proofs. Corrections should be kept to a minimum and should be corrections, not new material. Changes and corrections which exceed 5 % of original type-setting costs will be charged to the author if he is responsible for them.

Authors of articles receive 25 free offprints. Additional offprints will be supplied at cost price if ordered when the corrected proofs are returned. All contributions and correspondence should be addressed to: Schriftleitung *Paideuma*, Frobenius-Institut, Liebigstr. 41, D-6000 Frankfurt (Main).
